### ISSUES TO CONSIDER

A priority review of marking is only rarely helpful in securing university places

You must remember that it is possible that marks can be deducted as well as added when a paper is re-marked

Experience suggests that, unless it is an extreme case, it is usually only papers within three marks of a grade boundary that achieve the objective of a higher grade

In almost all cases a priority copy of the script is probably the best initial approach:

- Please note that the deadline for priority copies of scripts is the 23rd August which is before students return to College
- 6<sup>th</sup> September is the *"Date by which centres should receive priority copies of scripts to support enquiries about results"* (JCQ)
- This enables you to review the paper with your subject teacher prior to requesting a remark if required.
