From the results this year there have been a number of improvements. These include:

- Increase in strongly agree and agree responses in 8 areas
- 2% increase in parents who would recommend the school to another parent
- 7% increase in parents strongly agreeing that their child is happy at the College
- 5% increase in parents strongly agreeing that they receive valuable information about the College and that their child receives appropriate homework for their age.

The feedback from each questionnaire is discussed at leadership level and actions put into place to ensure that we continue to work together with our community to improve and inform. In a similar way to Ofsted and other school performance analysts, we tend to include the Don't Know responses with the positive indicators for the purposes of action planning
