Heathfield Community College Summer School 2021

The Summer School ran for 5 days in August 2021.

Year 6 into Year 7:

- 44 students were invited to attend the summer school.
- These students had been nominated by their Primary School as being those who would most benefit from this experience.
- 22/40 students accepted their offer of a place and attended the summer school
- Each day involved 4 lessons taught by subject specialists, including English, Maths, Design Technology and PE. Students also had a daily assembly and received a tour of the College so that they would get used to being in school.
- Students received a hot meal every day as part of the provision.

Year 7 into Year 8:

- 36 students were invited to attend the summer school.
- These students had been nominated by English and Maths teachers as being those who would most benefit from this experience. The curriculum was carefully designed to consolidate some of the key concepts/skills covered during Year 7.
- 18/36 students accepted their offer of a place and attended the summer school
- Each day involved 3 lessons taught by subject specialists, including English, Maths and PE.
- Students received a hot meal every day as part of the provision.
