Mobile Phones

As you know, our policy on mobile phones is that students can have them for travel to and from school but they must be turned off and put away during the school day. Most students follow this rule, and it has worked well.

Some schools are asking students to hand in phones at the start of the day, but we prefer not to use our resources to introduce the storage systems for this at the moment.

We would like to remind all students:

- Phones should be off and in bags by 8:33am, and not used again until after school.
- Any phone seen during the school day can be taken for the day (including held or visible in blazer pockets for example).
