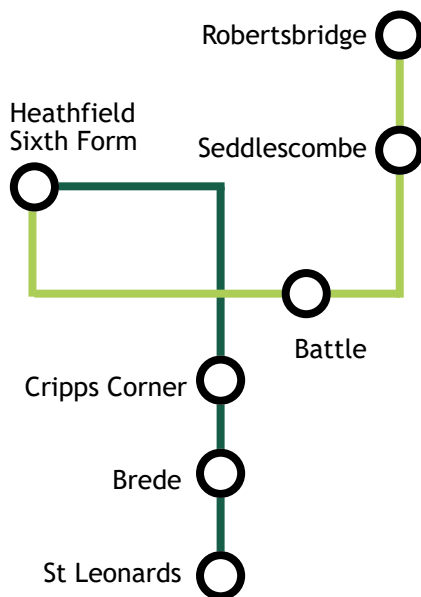
The Routes
